

## Eligibility for Extra-Curricular Activities

In order for students to maintain eligibility to participate in extra-curricular activities, students' work must be current (no missing assignments) with at least a "C" average (70%) in every class. Also, conduct must be satisfactory in all subject areas, including all specials (art, PE, music, etc.). Eligibility is determined each Monday. Students who do not meet this requirement will be ineligible to participate in the first meeting of each extra-curricular activity (Choir, Art Club, Student Council, etc.) that week and/or may not play in the first scheduled game or practice that week.

In order to determine eligibility, each student who participates in an extra-curricular activity is required to pick up an "Eligibility Form" from their homeroom teacher on Monday mornings. They will carry this form to all their classes that day. If a class does not meet on Monday (for example: 8<sup>th</sup> grade art or 7<sup>th</sup> grade PE), it is the responsibility of those teachers to contact the homeroom teachers by 11:30 a.m. on Monday with the names of students who are ineligible and why (grade, missing work, behavior, etc.). The homeroom teacher can then sign for that class during the afternoon homeroom period. Students should not be sent around to their teachers at the end of the day. It is their responsibility to take care of this at the appropriate time.

If ineligibility is due to missing work, the student should be turning in the work during the week. When missing work is turned in, it does **NOT** affect eligibility that week. Students may become eligible the following week when a new form is completed. **Eligibility is determined only ONCE during the week.**

It is the student's responsibility to bring the signed form to their coach or activity moderator that week to show eligibility in order to participate. If a child is not eligible, the form should be given to the parents. If a child shows up for an activity without a form, they should either be sent to extended day, or in the case of a game, sit on the bench. A new form must be completed each week to determine continued eligibility. The final decision of eligibility is at the discretion of the teacher and/or principal.
